

Applications are invited for Chair of the Scientific and Education Committee (SEC)

This is an opportunity for you to bring your expertise to chair the highly regarded Science and Education Committee of The Urology Foundation.



The Urology Foundation (TUF) was started by urologists to advance understanding and practice for the benefit of urology patients. We are the only charity in the UK and Ireland that covers all urological conditions and cancers. Our mission is to support and develop the best urology research, training and education that leads to the best possible patient care. TUF is administered by a Board of Trustees which includes urologists and lay people.

The appointment is for five years and the Chair will also sit on the Board of Trustees. This is an honorary post but expenses will be reimbursed.

The Chair's responsibilities are to:

- Promote The Foundation's work and programmes to the wider urological community.
- Oversee adjudication by the SEC and Reviewing Panel of Research Scholarship applications.
- Chair the annual meeting of the SEC and attend TUF board meetings as SEC representative.
- Oversee adjudication by SEC of Clinical Visit applications, Longer term Fellowship Applications and TUF's other research, education & travel programmes.
- Ensure that criteria decided upon by the Board of Trustees are applied to all grant applications (assuming these are in line with AMRC research principles).
- Answer queries from applicants.

Applicants should have experience of grant-giving bodies, chairing committees and supervising scientific research.

Applications should consist of a single sheet of A4 together with a brief CV (max 2pp) and emailed to:
