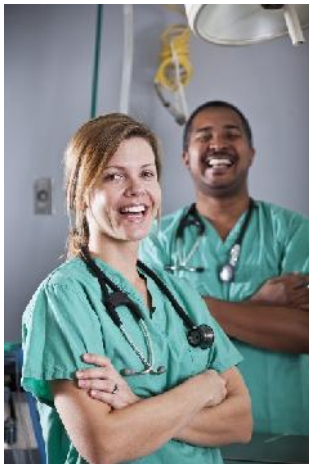

This is an opportunity for you to bring your expertise to join the highly regarded Science and Education Committee of The Urology Foundation.



The Urology Foundation (TUF) was started by urologists to advance understanding and practice for the benefit of urology patients. We are the only charity in the UK and Ireland that covers all urological conditions and cancers. Our mission is to support and develop the best urology research, training and education that leads to the best possible patient care. TUF is administered by a Board of Trustees which includes urologists and lay people.

The SEC meets once a year (usually in March) and ongoing business is usually conducted by email. SEC members have a chance to help shape The Foundation's funding priorities and programmes in coming years.

This is an honorary post but expenses will be reimbursed.

The Committee's responsibilities are to:

- Review and assess the annual Research Scholarship applications and decide on grant awards.
- Assess applications to TUF's other grant streams and decide on awards.
- Agree on priorities for funding and, where necessary, make recommendations for and suggest changes to TUF's awards programmes.
- Promote TUF's work and programmes to the wider urological community.
